They will cost only \$5 per session.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

SEASON 2009-10

in2CRICKET will commence on Saturday 3rd October, at Sunnybank Hills State School oval, from 8.30am to 10am, and will run until Saturday 5th December.

Competition games commence on Saturday 10th October. Matches are 2 day games on consecutive Saturdays, except for Under 10's, who play one-day games against teams from Park Ridge, Souths, Wests, Kenmore, Wolston Park Centenary & Moggill Cricket Clubs etc. The official hours of play are 8.15am to 11.45am every Saturday. The last day of play in the Pre-Christmas comp will be Saturday 5th December. Full details will be available from your team coach and manager soon.

HELMET POLICY

The Club has a policy of including helmets in the team kits for under 11 and 12 teams only. The coaches/managers of these teams will ask you if you want your child to wear a helmet when batting. Under 10's play with a "Softa" ball and a helmet is not required. We recommend that each child wear their own well-fitted helmet for under 13 and older.
